Summer Watering Rules Begin May 1st

Summer watering rules are enforced from May 1st until October 1st. Summer watering rules are:

- Water during cooler times of the day — lawn watering is not allowed between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- Water no more than three days per week.
- Do not allow water to pool in gutters, streets, and alleys.
- Do not waste water by letting it spray on concrete or asphalt.
- Repair leaking sprinkler systems within 10 days.
- Do not irrigate while it is raining or during high winds.
- Use a hose nozzle with a shut-off valve when washing your car.

Get Your Automatic Sprinkler System Ready for Prime Time

If you have an automatic sprinkler system, there are a few steps you can take to help prepare your system for the irrigation season. When you turn your system on, make sure you cycle through each zone to check for leaks. Most systems are set to run during nighttime or early morning hours. Cycling through the zones at startup helps identify underground leaks and missing or damaged heads that you may not otherwise see. Make sure to check your system control valves in the sprinkler box. A leaking control valve can allow water to run into your system even when a zone is not active. Also, don't forget to check your controller's settings if it loses power. Some controllers will revert to factory settings if they lose power.

Adjusting your sprinkler system's timer each month is a great way to save water and lower your bill while preserving your landscape. Watering times will depend on the type of sprinkler you use, the amount of precipitation you receive and your type of grass. Suggested average watering times per zone are:

Watering Month	Fixed Spray Heads	Rotor Heads	Rotary Nozzles	Manual Sprinklers
May	12	24	30	18
June	17	35	43	26
July	18	36	45	27
August	14	27	34	20
September	11	23	28	17

District Contractor Performing Routine Sanitary Sewer System Maintenance

Bancroft-Clover Water and Sanitation District is responsible for over 100 miles of sanitary sewer pipe. Each year, the District has approximately 190,000 feet of sewer pipe cleaned and inspected. Beginning in May, our contractor, Guildner Pipeline Maintenance, will begin jet cleaning and video inspection of the system. Guildner will be performing scheduled work in the area east of S. Garrison St. and south of W. Mississippi Ave. In addition, they will be servicing select areas throughout the system, which require more frequent maintenance. If you encounter crews working in your neighborhood, please drive slow and give crews plenty of room.
