### **District crews performing curb stop valve maintenance**

If your home's water meter is inside, you may have seen District crews performing maintenance on your curb stop valve. The curb stop valve is typically located in a grassy area, within a couple of feet of the sidewalk. The service box is covered by a small round lid with "water" embossed on it.

The curb stop valve allows the water to be shut off in case of a leak or another water emergency. When visiting a property, our field technicians make sure the valve is accessible and operable. If the valve cannot be operated, our crews may have to dig it up to replace it or reset the service box. If you have any questions or concerns regarding your curb stop valve, please call the District office at 303-922-1113.

### **Rain barrels are now legal in Colorado**

With the passage of Colorado House Bill HB 16-1005, rain barrels are now legal in Colorado. Residents may collect rainwater in up to two rain barrels with a combined storage capacity not to exceed 110 gallons. This water should only be used for normal outdoor uses such as watering trees, shrubs and flowers.

### **Sanitary Sewer Lines Cleaned and Video Inspected**

Bancroft-Clover Water and Sanitation District is responsible for over one hundred miles of sanitary sewer pipe. Each year the District's contractor, Guildner Pipeline Maintenance, jet cleans and video inspects over 180,000 feet of sewer mains. Video inspection allows the District's staff to identify portions of the system, which require additional maintenance or repair. In addition, the video inspection may allow us to proactively identify customer services obstructed by root growth. If we identify root growth in your service, we will send you a letter advising you of the condition.
